

Southern Corroboree Frog Nature craft.



Southern Corroboree frogs live in and around Sphagnum moss at the edge of pools. Males make nest chambers in the moss and call which attracts females, who lay eggs in the nest. Tadpoles move through the moss to find their way to water.

To make some Corroboree frogs you need:



a body:
smooth rock,
seedpod, bark



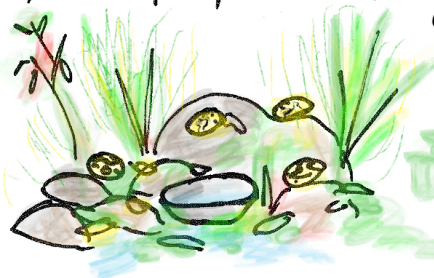
Colour! Yellow
and black, either
paint, chalk pen, or marker.



Nest Making Materials:
water, "Moss"-leaves,
bark, twigs, rocks, bowl
optional: chia seeds for
sensory play.



Step 1:
create yellow
and black patterns
on the rock, seedpod
or bark using the
paint or pens. every
corroboree frog has its own pattern!



Step 2:
create a home,
Nest & habitat for
your frog using
things you find in
the garden, don't
forget a pond!



Step 3:
In the bowl
pond you can
add chia seeds
and pretend they
are eggs, put them
in the mossy
Nest

Southern Corroboree Frog

recycled Materials puppet.

You need:



recycled cardboard,
eg. from a cereal
box



a plate
or bowl



scissors



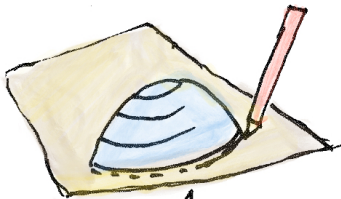
black
+ yellow
texta or
Paint or
pastels



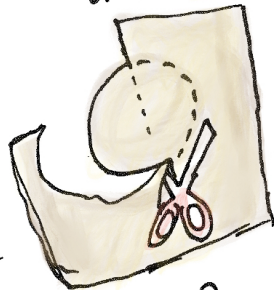
Masking
tape



a leaf
or bark
for a
frog tongue



Step 1
Trace a circle
onto recycled
cardboard around
a plate or bowl



Step 2
cut circle
out using
scissors



Step 3
Fold circle
in half



Step 4
Make a ring
of masking
tape, sticky side
out, around
fingers.



Step 5
Stick ring of
tape on one
side of circle.



Step 6
Tape over
the top of
the tape ring
to attach. do
this on both sides
of folded circle



Step 7
Fold open and
paint or draw
Corroboree frog
eyes & patterns
on the puppet.



Step 8
stick a
leaf tongue
inside, then
test out
your puppet!
Can it find
pretend ants
to eat?
