

MAKE YOUR OWN ANTELOPE HORNS

Wear some horns on your head, just like the antelopes at Werribee Open Range Zoo do!

DID YOU KNOW?

Even though the Scimitar-Horned Oryx is Extinct in the Wild, you can still see them for yourself on the savannah at Werribee Open Range Zoo.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Brown craft paper
- Rubber bands
- Split pins
- Scissors
- Popsicle or craft sticks
- Sticky tape
- Hole punch



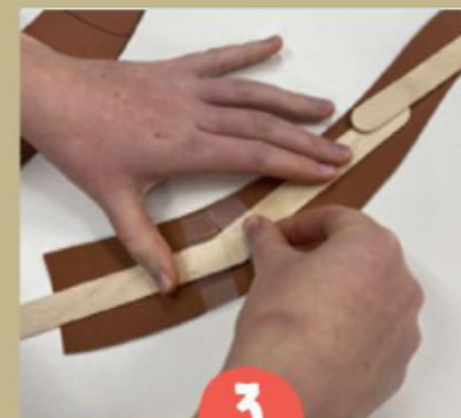

Cut out a long thin strip of craft paper and punch two holes in either end. This will become a headband.



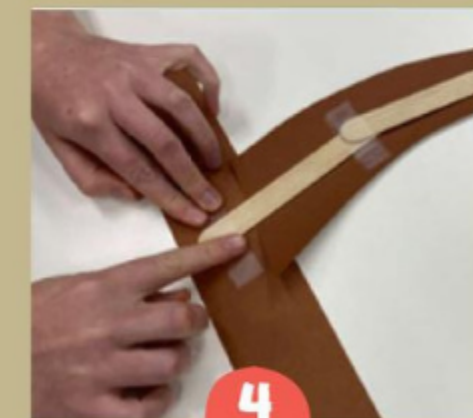

With the remaining craft paper, draw two antelope horns and cut them out.



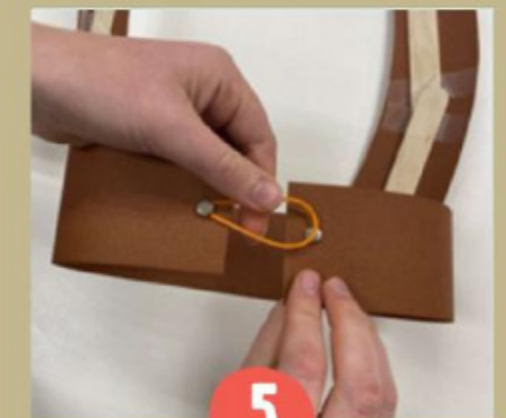

Line up to three craft sticks together along the length of each horn and tape down.

Tape both horns to the headband.

Finally, add a split pin to each end of the headband and loop a rubber band around each pin.

Pretend to be an antelope by galloping around!
